VEHICLE GUIDELINES

The Technical Committee has been asked by the Board of Directors to establish guidelines for an acceptable automobile as described in the Bylaws. The following are recommendations made by the Technical Committee.

BODY

The body should remain primarily unmodified. Non original period accessories such as continental kits or fender skirts etc. are allowable additions.

PAINT

The colors do not have to be original. It should however, be done either in a period correct manner or tastefully done as a period modified.

CHROME

Bumpers and stock chrome should remain primarily intact. Personalized changes may be acceptable if approved by the technical committee.

INTERIOR

Should be as original as possible. The material may be non-original. Safety items such as seatbelts are accepted and encouraged. Add-on air conditioning and sound systems are also accepted.

TIRES & WHEELS

Not restricted as to style and type. Dimensions should remain close to original.

ENGINE COMPARTMENT

Engine and engine compartment may be non-original as long as the vehicle meets all other specifications.

SUSPENSION

Not restricted. Upgraded suspension, brakes and steering to enhance ride, stability and safety are allowable.

Other modifications may be made to the vehicles to suit the personal taste and desire of the individual owner. All applicant vehicles must be at least 25 years old and are subject to approval by the technical committee. Vehicles include automobiles, trucks and motorcycles.
